Exclusion Criteria:

- 🔀 ASA Grades 3 & 4
- Weight >220kg
- Myocardial infarction or stroke within the last 6 weeks
- Patients who lack capacity
- Currently pregnant
- 🔀 Total dysphagia
- Fitted with a cardiac implantable device
- High risk of Creutzfeldt-Jakob disease
