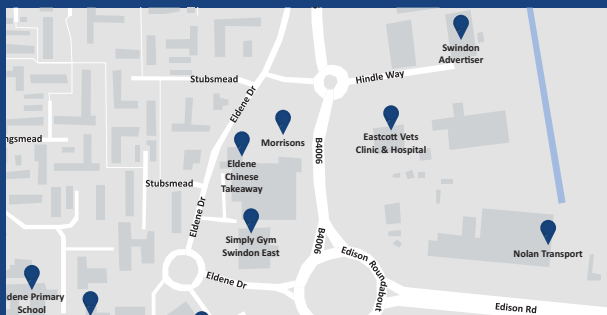

- ✓ Eczema

Minor Surgery:

- ✓ Diagnostic biopsy: Shave, punch, immunofluorescence biopsy

- ✓ Excision of BCCs – Below and above the clavicle

Exclusion Criteria:

- ✗ Excluded treatments based off site specific criteria*
 - * 2ww lesions – Melanoma/SCC
 - Excisions that require graft of flap - Under 16s - Suspected SCC or malignant melanoma - Conditions requiring biologics or DMARDs - Erythrodermic or systemically unwell patients requiring urgent assessment
 - Cosmetic procedures
