- ✓ Eczema (mild to moderate)
- ✓ Actinic keratosis
- ✓ Bowen's disease
- ✓ Acne (mild to moderate)
- ✓ Psoriasis (mild to moderate)
- ✓ Granuloma annulare
- ✓ Premalignant skin disease i.e Bowen's disease, solar keratosis
- ✓ Hair / nail / scalp disorders
- ✓ Fungal infections
- ✓ Lesion of diagnostic uncertainty
- ✓ Pruritus (mild to moderate)
- ✓ Lichen planus and sclerosis
- ✓ Alopecia / hair loss
- ✓ Urticaria
- ✓ Pigment disorders e.g. vitiligo, melasma
- ✓ Rosacea
- ✓ Rash of diagnostic uncertainty
- ✓ Skin lesions requiring second opinion
- ✓ Low risk BCCs
- ✓ Skin biopsies sampled through curetting, shave excision, punch and excision biopsy for diagnosis

Exclusion Criteria:

- ✗ Suspected melanoma / SCC (ref 2WW)
- ✗ High risk BCCs (i.e. above the clavicle)
- ✗ Acute dermatological emergencies
- ✗ Acute lesions in children
- ✗ Acute infection
- ✗ Phototherapy
- ✗ Patch or skin prick testing
- ✗ Wound / leg ulcers
- ✗ Acne requiring isotretinoin
- ✗ Removal of benign lesions which do not met SEL TAP policy. Symptomatic benign lesion which met criteria can be referred to minor surgery DES.
